## TAA High Point Awards at TCHS!

A TAA High Point winner will be awarded for the hunter, jumper, and dressage divisions at the Thoroughbred Classic Horse Show.

Horses are eligible for the TAA High Point award if they have been adopted or sold from a TAA-accredited organization or are currently being re-trained by a TAA-accredited organization. The highest placing horse in each division will be determined the winner. Classes within each division will be determined by number of eligible entries and will be announced the day of the show.

Participants must list their TAA-accredited organization on their show entry to be considered eligible for the TAA High Point Award.

The TAA High Point winner will receive a prize from the TAA with an approximate value of \$100.
